The event is organised in the framework of the "REGIONS2030: Monitoring the SDGs in the EU regions - Filling the data gaps", funded by the European Parliament and developed by the Joint Research Centre (JRC) in collaboration with DG REGIO and ESTAT. It is one of the 10 regional events organised in the framework of the project. The event is coorganised by the Piemonte Region and the Joint Research Centre. The results of the regional activities will be presented in the final event of the REGIONS2030 project on 5 December 2023, in Brussels.
